## Admission & Fees Academic Year 2008-2009

1. A student seeking accommodation should complete an application form and return it to the Director.
2. Students are required to attend an interview before being offered a place in Cleraun.
3. Accommodation is reserved upon payment of € 250 deposit which will be returned, less any dues, at the end of the year. In the case where a student, having taken up residence, wishes to leave before the end of the third term, the deposit will not be refundable since accommodation is offered and accepted for the full academic year or the duration of the course attended by the student.
4. The fee is a full board, seven-day fee which includes breakfast, lunch, dinner and supper. Lunches from Monday to Friday are an extra cost. The fee also covers the cost of blankets, bed linen, towels and central heating. A laundry service is available at a cost of €9 each time.
5. The fee, calculated assuming a 29-week academic year (terms plus exams), amounts to € 4,930 (equivalent to € 170 per week). It is payable in three instalments as follows:

September 2008	€ 2,040
January 2009	€ 2,040
March 2009	€ 850
<b>Total</b>	<b>€ 4,930</b>

6. Students staying for longer than 29 weeks will be charged at a rate of € 170 per week. Payment for lunches €4.00 (Monday to Friday) may be made at the end of the term or at the end of the year.
7. Students are admitted for one academic year, but applications for further periods are readily considered. Applications from students who are already in university doing undergraduate or postgraduate work are particularly welcome.
8. The residence opens its doors for the 2008-2009 academic year on Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> September 2008.
9. Students are expected to maintain the standards of the house with regard to dress, punctuality, tidiness and care of facilities. Since the residence aims to facilitate study and character development, residents are expected to co-operate in every reasonable way to help achieve this objective.
